OS Support

- macOS 10.12 (or above)
- Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 10

Loupedeck Software 2.0 supports

- Adobe Lightroom Classic CC (v7.3 and above)
- Phase One Capture One Pro (Beta support)
- Adobe Lightroom 6 (not fully supported)
 - o For full support please use Loupedeck software 1.5.2 (Win) or 1.5.1 (Mac).

New Features

- New develop preset set (courtesy of Loke Roos)
- 3 New buttons opened for Customizing, giving five in total
 - o Pick -button
 - Zoom (left)
 - o Zoom (right)
 - o C2
 - o C3
- New customizable options for C1
 - Basic -panel adjustments
 - Detail -panel adjustments (sharpening, noise reduction)
 - o Effects -panel adjustments
 - o Lens Correction -panel adjustments



- o (Raw) Calibration -panel adjustments
- o Split Toning -panel adjustments
- o Tone (Curve) -panel adjustments
- o Transform -panel adjustments
- Dial-press reset value adjustment can be set to a value other than zero
- New customization options for C2/C3
 - o Assignable tools:
 - Adjustment Brush
 - Radial Filter
 - Graduated Filter
 - Spot Removal
 - Red Eye Removal
 - Crop tool
 - o Auto Settings: White Balance
 - o New Zooming modes:
 - Zoom in/out (in 4 steps)
 - Zoom in/out (all 13 steps)
- New customization options for Export
 - o Open image in Photoshop
- When Crop tool is activated:
 - o C2 tilts crop area horizontally / vertically
 - o C3 changes crop overlay(s)
 - Assign pre-defined aspect ratios and develop presets to P1-P8



- When Brush tool is activated:
 - o C1 adjusts brush tip size
- New additional functions can be assigned to C1 dial rotate and dial press
- Different functions can be assigned to Custom Buttons C2 and C3 within the Develop- and Library modules of Lightroom
- Hidden Keyboard Modifiers.
 - Press FN and */COL to enable keyboard modifiers
 - o Following Functions available

* / COL : ESC* : SHIFT** : CTRL

• *** : Win Start/Command

• **** : ALT / Option

■ ***** : TAB

o FN and */COL disables Keyboard Modifiers



Currently Unavailable

- Option to save and load Loupedeck user profiles
- Speed/Sensitivity override for dials
- Loupe/Grid -view toggle on Library Module
- Hide Panels -feature (FN + Full Screen)
- Online user guidance when customizing controls

Known issues (Lightroom):

- Scandinavian keyboard layout:
 - o Rotate image left/right 90° unavailable
 - o Changing Brush tip size unavailable
- If the Loupedeck Software doesn't connect to Adobe Lightroom Classic CC:
 - Stop Loupedeck software from task/menu bar
 - Start Lightroom
 - o Restart Loupedeck software
- If Loupedeck Software cannot retrieve Lightroom configuration:
 - Run Loupedeck software from Lightroom Help-menu: Plug-in Extras -> Loupedeck Setup
- When Lightroom is not running Loupedeck gives limited keyboard functions:
 - Left/Right arrows jump one word / one space at the time
 - o Zoom = letter Z
 - o Full Screen = F



Known issues (Capture One):

- To use Loupedeck, before first use the Shortcut file must be manually selected:
 - o Edit menu -> Keyboard Shortcuts
- If Capture One doesn't have permission to create the Loupedeck shortcut file (i.e folder is write protected) Capture One will crash.
 - Change write access to the following folders: /Users/<User>/Library/Application Support/Capture One/KeyboardShortcuts
